- (b) INSTRUCTOR: This category can only be ustated inton-Tenure Track, Visiting, or Retired classifications. This category requires paichtappeoits with primary duties in the area of instruction. Instructor duties may include advising and mentoring responsibilities as well as professional development, for example but noted intot, involvement in design and development of courses and the curriculum, and departmental service.
 - (c) PROFESSOR OF PRACTICE: This category only be used in the Non-Tenure Track, Visiting, or Retired classification is category requires paid appointments with primary duties in the area of instruction. Professor Practice are required to maintain connections with industry such as maintaining professional certifications of training paid position(s) in their related field. A Professor of Practice shall have a substantial of experience equal to a tenured professor (normally a minimum of 12 years); a national finational reputation for excellence reflected in a record of significant accomplishments; and have terms ive background in a field and discipline relevant to the college, or departnow appointment at Oregon Tech.
 - (d) LIBRARIAN: This category can only be used in the Tenure Track or Tenured, Non-Tenure Track or Retired classifications. This classification paid appointments with primary duties in the university libraries.
 - (e) CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR/COORDINATOR: This category can only be used in the Non-Tenure Track, Visiting or Retired classifications category classification appointments with primary duties in medical science, clinical instruction or clinical research.
