

CONSTITUTIONS OF THE COLLEGE OF ATHLETICS

Intercollegiate Athletics

Article I  
Section 1  
The purpose of the College of Athletics is to promote and maintain the highest standards of intercollegiate sports and to provide a fair and equitable environment for all participants.

Section 2  
The College of Athletics shall be governed by a Board of Directors, which shall have the authority to make all decisions regarding the operation of the program.

Section 3  
The Board of Directors shall consist of representatives from the various departments of the college, including the President, Vice Presidents, and members of the faculty and staff.

Section 4  
The Board of Directors shall have the authority to appoint and remove the Director of Athletics, and to determine the Director's salary and benefits.

Section 5  
The Board of Directors shall have the authority to approve the budget for the College of Athletics, and to allocate funds for the program.

Section 6  
The Board of Directors shall have the authority to establish rules and regulations governing the conduct of intercollegiate sports, and to enforce these rules and regulations.

Section 7  
The Board of Directors shall have the authority to establish a code of conduct for athletes, and to enforce this code of conduct.

Section 8  
The Board of Directors shall have the authority to establish a system of awards and recognition for athletes, and to administer this system.

Section 9  
The Board of Directors shall have the authority to establish a system of scholarships for athletes, and to administer this system.

Section 10  
The Board of Directors shall have the authority to establish a system of student-athlete support services, and to administer this system.

Article II  
Section 1  
The Director of Athletics shall be responsible for the overall management and operation of the College of Athletics, and shall report to the Board of Directors.

Section 2  
The Director of Athletics shall have the authority to appoint and remove all coaches and staff members, and to determine their salaries and benefits.

Section 3  
The Director of Athletics shall have the authority to establish and enforce rules and regulations governing the conduct of intercollegiate sports, and to enforce these rules and regulations.

Section 4  
The Director of Athletics shall have the authority to establish a code of conduct for athletes, and to enforce this code of conduct.

Section 5  
The Director of Athletics shall have the authority to establish a system of awards and recognition for athletes, and to administer this system.

Section 6  
The Director of Athletics shall have the authority to establish a system of scholarships for athletes, and to administer this system.

Section 7  
The Director of Athletics shall have the authority to establish a system of student-athlete support services, and to administer this system.
