OegnState Library Collection Enhancement Grant

The library received agant of \$5,000 to enhance collections transpected for undeserved student populations. The grant funds were divided between course textbook reserves and enhancing DH focused collections.

The Oegon Techlibary purchased \$4,000 incurrent textbooks and course naterials. This provides low incone sturkerts course naterials on the first day of courses available through the library's reserves system. The library has received course to bookstore data covering course enrollment, required textbooks, and textbooks costs. Library staff expanded course reserves by identifying top enrolled courses and highest price ditextbooks.

Additionally, the library spent \$1,000 towards addressing issues in diversity, inclusion, and increasing a sense of belonging for CITEPOC sturberts. 
