


## Student Affairs Medical Withdrawal Request Form

A MedicalWithdrawalis requested when a student is suffering from a medical condition that prevents the completion of the term. A "W" will be placed on the student sOregon Tech Transcript. Students who receive a medical withdrawal may be placed on hold until the University can determine that the student is ready to return. Medical withdrawals can be complete for all courses or partial individual course (s) the student is registered in for the term. A medical withdrawal must be filed within six months of the end of the term involved. If a student is approved for medical withdrawal, the student may apply for a Tuition Refund Appeal through the Busines Affairs Office.

Supportingmedical documentation is required to be attached to this form to be considered for Medical Withdrawal. The letter in support of your Medical Withdrawal may be written by a physician counselow other medical provider, and must provide dates seen and recommend with drawal from class (es).
